Position: Simulation Specialist

Duties & Responsibilities:

Under supervision of the Simulation Team Leader, the regional Simulation Specialist is generally responsible as a MobileSim vehicle team member for the day-to-day delivery of the simulation curriculum and associated tasks:

Support Duties

- Perform vehicle and equipment set-up, operation, and breakdown for simulation sessions, training, and maintenance needs.
- Complete daily vehicle, manikin, and systems maintenance checks, activities, cleaning, and reporting requirements.
- Have working knowledge and perform troubleshooting of manikin and associated systems.
- Function as vehicle driver if qualified.
- Other support duties as assigned.

Education Duties

- Implement simulation session curriculum and function as an educator for MobileSim MT simulation events.
- Provide evaluation and feedback of individual participant, healthcare team, and system performance as required by simulation event objectives and curriculum.
- Perform collection of evaluation data on learning outcomes for simulation activities and collaborate with STL and other MobileSim region staff, simulation group members, and administration to disseminate findings.
- Collaborate with simulation group, STL, and administration to develop simulation scenarios to promote student learning, critical thinking, and clinical decision making.
- Maintain a professional and positive image of Best Practice Medicine and the MobileSim MT program.
- Maintain simulation program education and professional standards in accordance with program policies and procedures as listed in the Employee Handbook.
- Other duties as assigned.
